INVITATION TIPS:

- Invite, Invite. To fill a table of 10, you should invite 20-25 people. If you end up with more than 9 guests, that's ok! We will place them at an adjacent table and work with you on seating. Use our <u>Guest Brainstorm Tool</u> to help you keep track of who you should invite.
- **Follow up is key.** Oftentimes, people won't respond to your first email/invitation so follow up by email/phone/text/in-person. Then follow up again.

WHAT TO DO WHEN ...:

- They say yes! Congrats! You are one step closer to filling your table.
 - Make sure they <u>register online</u> so that we capture their email and food preferences.
 - Let them know you will reach out closer to the event to confirm their attendance.
 - Ask them if they know of anyone else who might be interested in attending.

They say no.

- Ask them if they'd consider <u>making a donation</u> to support your efforts and be your "virtual guest." Tell them to list you in the "Honor/Memorial" section. We will share an event video with them as a special thank you.
- You already know they cannot make the event.
 - This is still a great time to invite them to learn more about an organization you really care about. Let them know that you understand they cannot make it to the event, and ask them to make a virtual guest gift online and to list you as their table captain.
